Our pediatric occupational therapists can evaluate and treat conditions such as developmental delay, PDD, ADHD, autism spectrum disorder, Asperger's, and more in a dedicated movement and quiet area to meet your child's needs. Some of our pediatric treatments include constraint-induced movement therapy to strengthen the upper extremities; aquatics for sensory and neurological conditions; and Interactive Metronome to help with sensory integration disorder, ADD/ADHD, CP, Asperger's, and autism spectrum disorder.



We provide a variety of ADL (activities of daily living) programs using adaptive equipment and strategies in the areas of bathing and dressing, feeding, cooking/meal preparation, low vision, and computers. We also implement cognitive retraining (money management, problem solving, safety concerns). Plus, we have a fully functional training bathroom and kitchen.

Our occupational therapists will work to re-educate you on coordination, balance, movement, and proprioception that can be lost with neurological diagnoses. We use a number of tools to assist in normalizing and increasing upper extremity muscle tone. The BTE work simulator, Bioness H200, SaeboFlex and SaeboReach, combined with fine and gross motor retraining can improve bilateral arm use for increased independence.

Occupational therapy also offers balance retraining, arthritis education, driver's rehabilitation, and wheelchair evaluations.

OUR SPEECH THERAPISTS treat the complete range of speech and language impairments with compassion and one-on-one care. Using the latest in speech therapy technology, they work with children and adults and can help you overcome your impairment.

Our Services

To diagnose swallowing disorders, we have the Fiberoptic Endoscopic Evaluation of Swallowing (FEES), which provides state-of-the-art evaluation of swallowing with superior, real-time color images. We can also perform videofluoroscopy evaluation of swallowing. We use VitalStim® neuromuscular electrical stimulation to treat dysphagia (difficulty swallowing) and oro-motor weakness. VitalStim can also improve airway protection during swallowing and can be effective in treating facial droop.

We assist patients with aphasia to help them regain as much of their communication skills as possible and develop communication strategies for deficits.

For patients with voice disorders, the Lee Silverman Voice Treatment® helps patients with Parkinson's improve voice, speech, and other oro-facial functions. The Visi-Pitch IV is a computerized voice analysis system that helps us treat disorders like vocal hoarseness, vocal cord paralysis, vocal cord polyps; pediatric patients' speech/language therapy; and much more.

In addition, we provide treatment for cognitive disorders, dysarthria, and accent modification.
